Marcia Nelson
Deputy Minister, Alberta Health



Marcia Nelson was appointed Deputy Minister of Alberta Health and Wellness in October 2011. In her role as Deputy Minister, Marcia is responsible for leading and supporting quality health services, leading the health system, and working collaboratively with partners.

In March 2008, Marcia was appointed Deputy Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs. Marcia was responsible for leading the development of 11,000 affordable housing units by 2012, the implementation of Alberta's 10 Year Plan to End Homelessness, and ensuring public land is made available for affordable housing purposes.

Marcia joined the Alberta public service in 2002 as Assistant Deputy Minister of Strategic Services for Alberta Human Resources and Employment where she was responsible for developing Alberta's policy framework on immigration, strategic and business planning, intergovernmental relations, applied research and evaluation, and legislative services.

Marcia has a Master of Arts in Public Policy and Administration and a BA in Canadian Studies and Sociology both from McMaster University.
