Speaker Biography: Dr. Juzwishin is Director of Health Technology Assessment and Innovation at Alberta Health Services and is an adjunct associate professor at three Canadian universities. He is also a member of a committee that assists the government in the provincial review of health technologies and services. Dr. Juzwishin was CEO of the Health Council of Canada reporting on the progress of health care reform in Canada. Before this, he was the Director of HTA at the Alberta Heritage Foundation for Medical Research where he led a team of research associates responding to HTA requests from government, health authorities and provider organizations. Dr. Juzwishin was the chair of INAHTA’s Education and Training Working Group as well as the Public Agency Sub Group of Health Technology Assessment International (HTAi). He has experience in health administration, government, private sector, education and serves as a consultant to the World Health Organization on HTA of medical devices.
