Professor Abbyann Lynch is a Member of the Order of Canada, as well as the Order of Ontario; she holds several honorary degrees.

She is the Founding Director of Ethics in Health Care Associates (1994-present); this group of consultants provides ethics assistance to members of the Regulated Health Professions groups in Ontario and throughout Canada.

Dr. Lynch served as Director of Westminster Institute for Ethics and Human Values in London, Ont (1986-90); she was the Founding Director of the Department of Bioethics at The Hospital for Sick Children in Toronto (1991-1994); she was a tenured Associate in the Philosophy Department at the University of Toronto for 10 years.

Currently, Professor Lynch has just completed her services as Ethics Consultant, City of Toronto. She is a Board member of SPRINT (Senior People's Resources in North Toronto), as well as a Board member of ACE (Advocacy Centre for the Elderly – a legal clinic serving Low-Income Seniors in Toronto)
