Provincial Health Services Authority (PHSA) is one of six health authorities; it ensures that BC residents have access to a coordinated network of high-quality specialized health care services. PHSA operates provincial agencies including BC Children's Hospital, BC Transplant, and BC Cancer Agency. Recently, PHSA assumed responsibility for the Emergency and Health Services Commission, the British Columbia Ambulance Service, and the Health Shared Services BC organization.

Lynda Cranston, CEO, will acquaint us with the new initiatives happening at PHSA, including the Children's and Women's Redevelopment Project using Lean, Health Shared Services BC and Lower Mainland Consolidation.

Mrs. Cranston was awarded the 2008 Board Chair Award of Excellence by the HealthCare Leaders' Association of British Columbia. In 2007, she was inducted into Canada's Most Powerful Women Top 100™ Hall of Fame, and was named one of Canada's Most Powerful Women Top 100™ for 3 years (2004, 2005 & 2006). Mrs. Cranston is a recipient of the YWCA Women of Distinction Award, the 125th Anniversary of the Confederation of Canada Commemorative Medal for community contributions, and the Queen's Golden Jubilee Medal for contribution to Canada and community.
