- **Rick Roger**, Former CEO VIHA

In his talk, Mr. Rick Roger, former VIHA CEO, will offer his thoughts on what leadership is, what it is not and what it should be in a modern healthcare system. He will explore the relationship between leadership and management and the importance of understanding the complex environment within which health care in Canada is delivered. Reflecting on his personal experience, he will offer guidance on the problems and predicaments which one faces when thrust into leadership roles at any level.

Rick Roger is a health service consultant and a frequent volunteer with local, provincial and national bodies. Rick Roger was appointed to the Board of Worksafe BC in late 2008 as a public interest representative, Rick became Board vice chair in 2010. Rick also sits on the British Columbia Institute of Technology Board and is Chair of the Board of IMPACT BC, a Ministry funded organization committed to quality and service improvement on a system wide scale. He is the former Chief Executive Officer of the Vancouver Island Health Authority, the Capital Health Region and the Vancouver/Richmond Health Board. His background includes experience as the Associate Deputy Minister of Health in Saskatchewan and in a variety of health planning and finance roles.
